Principal's Report

Hi Everyone,

Our School Improvement Plan and Investing 4 Success 2018 are available on our website. Reading, Numeracy and Attendance continue to be our 3 big School Improvement items.

We are supporting Reading by having Roadvale Readers' Recognition in the Library from 8.15am, we also provide 1 on 1 support for Sight Words and alphabet recognition. Thank you to Mr David Cremer for being a volunteer at our school. If you would like to help with these programs please see Mrs Keidge or myself. We also support literacy by purchasing additional Teacher Aide time to allow for smaller groups to work with an adult. We also continue to build expert teaching teams by participating in professional learning.

Numeracy is supported with small group lessons with a school focus on Problem Solving. We also use Mathletics which can be accessed at home. Each child has an individual user name and logon.

95 % Attendance has been hampered by some illnesses. We do encourage attendance every day. If you have concerns about whether your child is well enough please talk to us. Students who have 95% attendance will be invited to have lunch with the principal. If you miss school – you miss learning – and you miss opportunities.
