Guarantee that every student will either:

- Achieve NMS in Literacy for their year level or,
- Have an evidence based learning plan in place to address their specific learning needs.
- Maintain Year 3 students meeting NMS in Reading at 80% for 2021
- Increase the % of Year 3 students in the U2B in Reading from 20% to 30% by 2021
- Develop a learning plan for every student currently below NMS in literacy
- To improve teacher and teacher aide capability through focused professional development to improve student performance using{'The Art & Science of Reading' – Marzano}.

Our initiatives include

- Engaging in regular student data discussions – Pre & Post tests, Early Start Data, Literacy Continuum
- Providing feedback to students and set individual goals {Visible Learning for Teachers – Hattie}.
- Building teacher capability in Explicit Teaching, Age Appropriate Pedagogy, Phonemic Awareness through coaching and mentoring.
- Resourcing Whole School Literacy Blocks.
- Providing Individual and small group intervention in Speech and Language
- Embedding 'Robust Vocabulary Intervention' in Literacy Block
- Embedding Phonemic Awareness Program in Prep - 2
- Embedding ongoing cycle of data collection and Case Management practices and monitoring individual student progress – Early Start, Literacy Continuum

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Developing an expert teaching team by undertaking professional development using 'The Art & Science of Reading' – Marzano. Purchase 5 copies @ \$53.40 **\$267**
- Embedding a Whole School Approach to Reading with planned regular Learning Walks.
Purchase 3 TRS days to release staff to watch others work and to provide immediate feedback. 2 days in Semester 1 & 1 day Semester 2 @ \$465per day **\$1395**
- Purchasing teacher aide time to work with students during Literacy Block for 365 hours X \$40 **\$14 600**
